A. Getting to Pendleton:

1. By air:

2. By road:

a) From Portland, Oregon

Take I-84 East to Exit 207, Turn left over the overpass and then merge slightly right and follow signs toward City Center. Turn left at BMCC sign onto Carden Avenue. Make immediate left again at the BMCC sign. At the top of the hill, turn left and follow the road around to Umatilla Hall and park below the building.



b) From Pasco, Washington

Take Highway 395 South to I-82. Take I-82 South to I-84 (Approximately 35 miles to I-84). Take I-84 East to Exit 207, Turn left over the overpass and then merge slightly right and follow signs toward City Center. Turn left at BMCC sign onto Carden Avenue. Make immediate left again at the BMCC sign. At the top of the hill, turn left and follow the road around to Umatilla Hall and park below the building.





c) From Boise, Idaho

Take I-84 West (in Idaho) to Exit 207 (in Oregon) Turn right onto Westgate Avenue and follow signs toward City Center. Turn left at BMCC sign onto Carden Avenue. Make immediate left again at the BMCC sign. At the top of the hill, turn left and follow the road around to Umatilla Hall and park below the building.



d) From Walla Walla, Washington

Take Highway 11 Southeast following signs to Pendleton City Center. Turn slightly right onto SE Court Avenue. Follow SW Court (HWY 30) through the City Center. After the Pendleton Round-Up grounds make a slight right and continue on as it becomes Westgate. Make a right turn after the Umatilla River Bridge. Go one block and turn left onto Carden Avenue. Immediately turn right at the BMCC sign and proceed up the hill. At the top of the hill, turn left and follow the road around to Umatilla Hall and park below the building.










Blue Mountain Community College campus map
